

Part-time working as ICT coordinator


Main function



Project "Improving the competence of school staff coordinating ICT activities in schools" activities

1 step. Promotion of SELFIE (all project time)

- Online and print paper material
- Presentation in conferences, exhibitions
- 1-day seminar for ICT coordinators

2 step. Blended course for ICT coordinators (spring-summer 2019)

- 15 modules (each 1 academic credit) correspond with SELFIE elements
- Possibilities choose 3 or more modules to depend on ICT coordinator needs // Suitable for self-study
- Focus on practical activities // Examples, recommendation of how to organize ICT activities from a pedagogical, managerial and technological point of view
- Illustrative (at least two videos in the module)
- Practical assignments and self-tests
- The Open Badge system
- Short learning recommendations for learners

3 step. Searching lecturer (summer 2019, 28 people)

4 step. Training activities (2019/2020 academic year, 754 persons)
